Professional Experience

Toby served in the United States House of Representatives as the member from Connecticut's 6th congressional district from 1975 to 1983. During his four terms in the U.S. House of Representatives, he served as chairman of the House Subcommittee on Environment, Energy and Natural Resources, where he oversaw national investigations into Clean Air Act violations, groundwater contamination and nuclear power plant safety.



During his career at Mayer Brown, Toby led the global law firm's interaction with government leaders both in the U.S. and abroad, having co-founded and co-chaired the firm's global Africa practice. He led the creation of Mayer Brown partnerships with law firms across the continent and was responsible for creating the firm's presence in Casablanca, Morocco. Prior to his Mayer Brown tenure, Toby was the founder and chairman of The Moffett Group, an advocacy firm representing clients in the private and NGO sectors.
